To amend the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, by adding in Chapter 29, Traffic and Motor Vehicles, Article VI, Stopping, Standing and Parking, a new section numbered Sec. 29-243.10 to declare it to be unlawful for a person to park a motor vehicle in a fire lane of a parking area or lot designed to accommodate fifty or more vehicles.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be amended by adding therein in Chapter 29 a new section numbered Sec. 29-243.10 as follows:

Sec. 29-243.10. Parking lots providing accommodation for fifty or more vehicles; prohibiting parking in fire lanes.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle in any lane marked and designated as a "fire lane" within or adjacent to a parking area or parking lot that is open to the public and which lot is designed to accommodate fifty (50) or more vehicles, and any police officer or parking meter attendant employed by the bureau of police may issue a summons, citation, or a written notice charging a person with violation of this section.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect March 1, 1987.
