

AN ORDINANCE No. 87-66-65

ADOPTED APR 13 1987

To authorize the Richmond River Festival Committee to use Brown's Island, Chapel Island, Great Ship Locks Park and Richmond Intermediate Terminal for the River Festival '87, which will include live entertainment, erection of tents, sale of foods and other items, open fires for cooking demonstrations, banners and decorative items (not to be attached to electrical poles), the sale of alcoholic beverages (beer only), and camping (night to be spent in the park for security purposes) on Friday, May 8, through Sunday, May 10, 1987.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning sale of merchandise in the public parks of the City of Richmond, and any other applicable provisions of law of the City to the contrary notwithstanding, Richmond River Festival Committee may use Brown's Island, Chapel Island, Great Ship Locks Park and Richmond Intermediate Terminal for the River Festival '87, which will include live entertainment, erection of tents, sale of foods and other items, open fires for cooking demonstrations, banners and decorative items (not to be attached to electrical poles), the sale of alcoholic beverages (beer only), and camping (night to be spent in the park for security purposes) on Friday, May 8, through

Sunday, May 10, 1987. Richmond River Festival Committee shall obtain and provide a policy or policies of public liability insurance in an amount of \$1,000,000, in which the City of Richmond shall be named as an additional insured. Richmond River Festival Committee shall obtain permits, approvals and licenses as may be required by the Departments of Finance, Public Health, Public Safety and Public Utilities, and by the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission. In addition the Richmond River Festival Committee shall comply with requirements of the Department of Public Safety concerning police (including the use of off duty personnel of the Bureau of Police) and other security measures.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, May 8, 1987, and shall continue in force until 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 10, 1987.
