MOTIONS TO AMEND

1. To amend Ord. No. 2016-033, which amends ch. 2, art. III, div. 7 of the City Code by adding therein a new section 2-216, concerning the obstruction of inspector general investigations, to provide that certain employees who obstruct inspector general investigations by denying the Office of the City Auditor, when not required by law to so deny, immediate access to information are subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination by their appointing authority, to clarify that the new section refers only to the inspector general function of the Office of the City Auditor.
2. To amend Ord. No. 2016-253, which authorizes the Chief Administrative Officer to execute a Programmatic Project Administration Agreement Extension Addendum between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation, to instead authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to execute a new Programmatic Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation for the development and administration of previously authorized and future Revenue Sharing Program projects.

ORDINANCES

3. To provide for the granting by the City of Richmond to the person, firm or corporation to be ascertained in the manner prescribed by law of certain easements upon, over, under, and across certain property located in Joseph Bryan Park at 4308 Hermitage Road for the construction, maintenance, and operation of sewer improvements and associated appurtenances in accordance with a certain Deed of Utilities Easement. **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – October 18, 2016}**
4. To amend and reordain Ord. No. 2007-251-209, adopted Sept. 24, 2007, as previously amended by Ord. No. 2008-117-93, adopted May 27, 2008, and Ord. No. 2013-117-113, adopted Jun. 24, 2013, concerning the establishment of a residential permit parking district in the Carver Neighborhood, for the purpose of adding certain streets and portions of streets to the Carver Residential Permit Parking District. (Mr. Samuels) **{Land Use, Housing, and Transportation – October 18, 2016}**
5. To amend and reordain City Code §§ 26-361 and 26-431, concerning interest on delinquent taxes, for the purpose of fixing the annual rate of interest for delinquent taxes at ten percent. **{Finance and Economic Development – October 20, 2016}**
6. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$131,910.31 from AIG/Lexington Insurance Company and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Capital Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Major Building Renovations project in the City Facilities category by \$131,910.31 for the

purpose of applying insurance proceeds to the repair of the roof of a City-owned building located at 1700 Commerce Road. **{Planning Commission – November 7, 2016}**

7. To amend and reordain Ord. No. 84-228-207, adopted Sept. 24, 1984, as previously amended by Ord. No. 84-253-226, adopted Oct. 22, 1984, and Ord. No. 2010-30-38, adopted Feb. 22, 2010, which authorized the special use of the property known as 5611 Grove Avenue for the purposes of personal services and non-medical office uses, to authorize retail stores and shops and art galleries, upon certain terms and conditions. 8. To rezone the properties known as 5903 Grove Avenue, 6001 Grove Avenue, 6 Maple Avenue, 10 Maple Avenue, 5604 Cary Street Road, 5606 Cary Street Road, and 5902 Three Chopt Road from the R-1 Single-Family Residential District to the IC Institutional District (Conditional).
