(a) Transferring \$75,000.00 from the Department of Public Works agency for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023;



**PURPOSE:** To amend Ord. No. 2022-055 which adopted the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 General Fund Budget and create a new line item in the Non-Departmental Organizational Subsidy entitled Venture Richmond Inc. (Graffiti Removal – Downtown) with an appropriation of \$75,000.

**REASON:** This paper would allow Venture Richmond, Inc. to address graffiti removal in their downtown service area.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends approval.

**BACKGROUND:** The City of Richmond’s Department of Public Works in coordination with the Downtown Task Force and Venture Richmond have identified over 50 locations within Venture

Richmond's service area that are in need of graffiti removal. These locations require extensive removal which cannot be performed by City staff and is best suited for specialty contractors. Through the Downtown Task Force and in collaboration with Venture Richmond the department has outlined a comprehensive approach that will address these locations and aide in preventing future "tagging" in the area.
