Site Description	The site currently includes the Pine Camp Arts Building and Pine Camp green space.	
Scope of Review	The project is subject to location, character, and extent review under section 17.05 and 17.07 of the Richmond City Charter.

Project Description	The Applicant states: Construction of 16ftx24ft outdoor classroom behind the main Pine Camp Arts Building.	

The space to include the outdoor classroom is adjacent to a wooded area and will add to the facilities offerings for outdoor recreation and programing. The structure will be timber frame and shingles roof. There will not be a concrete pad beneath. Staff recommends approval.
UDC recommended approval through the Consent Agenda. The UDC discussed what flooring was provided under the pavilion and the use of tree stumps for seating. The Applicant confirmed that mulch is proposed and stump seating is already intended.
