To amend the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, by adding in Chapter 20, Offenses, a new section numbered 20-150.2 concerning waiting period for the purchase of certain ammunition.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended by adding in Chapter 20 a new section numbered 20-150.2 as follows:

Sec. 20-150.2. Waiting period.

When the permit provided for in section 20-150, above, is for the purchase or procurement of ammunition which may be known as "cop-killing ammunition", the director of public safety shall not issue such permit for a period of fifteen (15) days from the date of the filing of an application for such permit. For the purposes of this section "cop-killing ammunition" shall mean any projectile capable of being discharged by a firearm, by means of gun powder, and is manufactured from materials used and/or designed to be used in the manufacture of armour piercing bullets. This shall include, but is not limited to, exploding bullets and those coated with teflon (R) or other highly lubricated material which reliable tests have indicated facilitates penetration of ballistic materials such as kevlar (R).

**SUMMARY**

This Ordinance would amend the Code, by adding a new section numbered Sec. 20-150.2 concerning waiting period for the purchase of certain ammunition.

A 15-day waiting period shall be established for the purchase of ammunition known as "cop-killing ammunition" such as: exploding bullets, bullets coated with teflon, or other highly lubricated material that allows penetration of material such as Kevlar.
