Consent Agenda

2. [CPCR.2026.001](#) RESOLUTION OF THE RICHMOND CITY PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVING A FINAL COMMUNITY UNIT PLAN AMENDMENT FOR STONY POINT SHOPPING CENTER, TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SECOND DRIVE-THRU LANE LOCATED AT 9006 WEST HUGUENOT ROAD, WITHIN MAP PARCEL A OF THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE STONY POINT COMMUNITY UNIT PLAN.

This item was approved.

3. [ORD. 2026-042](#) To amend and reordain Ord. No. 1994-219-209, adopted Oct. 10, 1994, which authorized the special use of the property known as 2107-2117 West Cary Street, for the purpose of the construction of a twelve-unit multi-family dwelling and six single-family attached dwellings, upon certain terms and conditions, to modify the terms and conditions. (5th District)

This ordinance was recommended for approval to the City Council.

1. Amend the ordinance to revise all references to “2107–2117 West Cary Street” to read “2107–2119 West Cary Street.”

4. [ORD. 2026-043](#) To amend and reordain Ord. No. 2024-116, adopted May 13, 2024, which authorized the special use of the property known as 1515 Chamberlayne Parkway for the purpose of a mixed-use building containing up to 91 dwelling units, upon certain terms and conditions, to modify the plans and the terms and conditions. (3rd District)

This ordinance was recommended for approval to the City Council.

5. [ORD. 2026-044](#) To rezone the property known as 1240 Ingram Avenue from the M-1 Light Industrial District to the TOD-1 Transit-Oriented Nodal District. (6th District)

This ordinance was recommended for approval to the City Council.

Regular Agenda

6. [ORD. 2025-258](#) To authorize the special use of the properties known as 6320 Daytona Drive, 6330 Daytona Drive, and 6340 Daytona Drive for the purpose of up to eight single-family detached dwellings, upon certain terms and conditions. (9th District)

This ordinance was recommended for approval to the City Council with the following amendments:

1. Update all references in the ordinance to the special use from "eight single-family detached dwellings" to "five single-family detached dwellings".
2. Replace the document titled, "Sketch Showing the Proposed Improvements on a Re-Division Lots 2, 3 & 4, 'Daytona Dell' in the City of Richmond, VA", dated July 30, 2024, and last revised August 27, 2025 with the proposed new site plan titled "Sketch Showing the Proposed Improvements on a Re-Division Lots 2, 3 & 4, 'Daytona Dell' in the City of Richmond, VA", dated July 30, 2024, and last revised February 23, 2026.
3. Revise Section 2(a) to change the revision date for the plans titled, "Sketch Showing the Proposed Improvements on a Re-Division Lots 2, 3 & 4, 'Daytona Dell' in the City of Richmond, VA" from August 27, 2025 to February 23, 2026.
4. Revise Section 3(d) to read "No fewer than five off-street parking spaces shall be provided for the Special Use, substantially as shown on the Plans."
5. Revise Section 3(f) to read "Prior to the issuance of any building permit for the Special Use, the establishment of up to five residential lots, and accompanying conveyance to the City of a permanent nine-foot-wide public easement, substantially as shown on the Plans, shall be accomplished by obtaining the necessary approvals from the City and recording the appropriate plats and deeds among the land records of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the City of Richmond."
