Hi Josh,

I looked at the Monroe Park maple today (tree ID# 74659). It is in decline. The canopy is roughly 40% dead, bark has fallen away from about 1/3 of the trunk and buttress roots, and shelf conk mushrooms, an indicator of decay, are fruiting on the trunk. The Magnolia (tree ID# 74661) is in good health and is worthy of preservation.
