Introduction

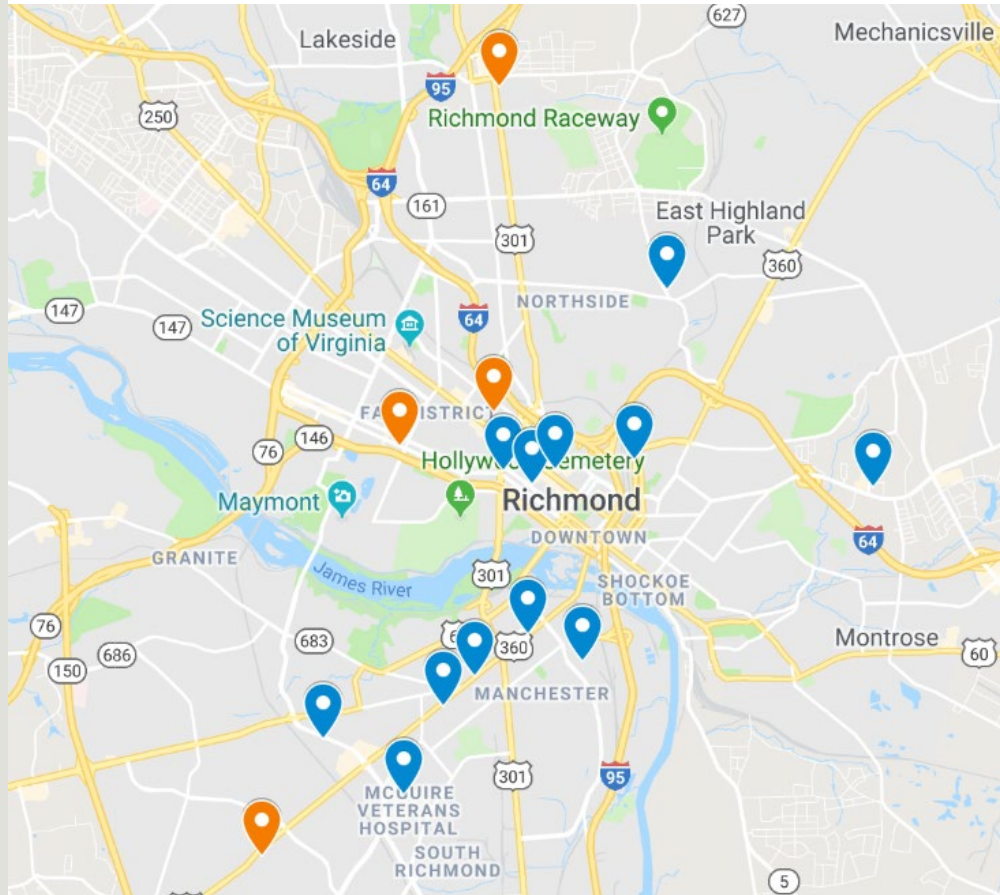
Thank you for the opportunity to update the City Council on the actions taken to facilitate homeless services for the City's unhoused residents.
