

AN ORDINANCE *No. 85-229-216*

ADOPTED SEP 9 1985

To amend the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, by adding in Chapter 9, City Owned Real Estate, Article VIII, Use of Public Grounds, Parks, Play Fields and Playgrounds, a new division entitled: "Division 3. Festival Park", consisting of Sections 9-345 through 9-353, inclusive, regulating activities in and around the Festival Park.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be
3. amended by adding in Chapter 9, Article VIII, a new
4. division, entitled: "Division 3. Festival Park", consisting
5. of sections 9-345 through 9-353, inclusive, as follows:
6. DIVISION 3. FESTIVAL PARK
7. Sec. 9-345. Festival Park designated; maintenance.
8. The Festival Park is that park area located between
9. the Sixth Street Marketplace and the Coliseum. Maintenance
10. of the Festival Park shall be the responsibility of the
11. Director of Recreation and Parks. The provisions of Article
12. VIII of Chapter 9 of this Code shall apply to the Festival
13. Park except as specifically provided in this division. A
14. violation of any section within this division shall
15. constitute a Class 1 misdemeanor.

1. Sec. 9-346. Playing radios without headphones.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to play or use any
3. radio, tape player, phonograph, megaphone or any other
4. equipment that produces recorded, broadcast or other
5. amplified sound. This section shall not prevent the use of
6. radios, tape players or phonographs if the user of such
7. equipment wears headphones and such equipment can be heard
8. by no other person in the park. This section shall not
9. apply to events approved or sponsored by Richmond Redevelop-
10. ment and Housing Authority, its designee or the City.

11. Sec. 9-347. Sales in park prohibited; exceptions.

12. No person shall sell or offer for sale any food,
13. beverage or merchandise within the Festival Park or within
14. one hundred (100) feet of the Festival Park. The Director
15. of Recreation and Parks shall not grant concessions for the
16. Festival Park. Sales of food, beverage or merchandise shall
17. be permitted only in connection with events approved or
18. sponsored by Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority,
19. its designee or the City.

20. Sec. 9-348. Skateboards prohibited.

21. No person shall use a skateboard within the Festival
22. Park.

23. Sec. 9-349. Unauthorized vehicles prohibited.

24. No person, unless specifically authorized, shall drive

1. any vehicle onto the grounds of the Festival Park. This
2. section shall not apply to persons authorized to operate
3. bureau of police vehicles, City vehicles used for
4. maintenance, emergency vehicles or to vehicles traveling
5. along paved surfaces to deliver goods or equipment in
6. connection with an event or activity approved or sponsored
7. by Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority, its
8. designee or the City.

9. Sec. 9-350. Animals prohibited; exceptions.

10. It shall be unlawful for any person to take any dog,
11. horse or other animal under his control into the Festival
12. Park. This section shall not apply to dog guides as
13. described in section 63.1-17.2 of the Code of Virginia or to
14. dogs or horses used by the members of the bureau of police.

15. Sec. 9-351. Hours open to the public.

16. The Festival Park shall be open to the public from
17. 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. of the following morning. No person
18. shall enter or remain upon the grounds of the Festival Park
19. during the hours of 3:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

20. Sec. 9-352. Tables, structures prohibited; exceptions.

21. No person shall place any table or erect any structure
22. within the Festival Park. This section shall not apply to
23. events approved or sponsored by Richmond Redevelopment and
24. Housing Authority, its designee or the City.

1. Sec. 9-353. Throwing balls, frisbees, etc., prohibited.
2. No person shall throw any ball, frisbee or any other
3. object within the Festival Park.
4. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon
5. adoption.
