

Future of Workforce Commission

Vacancies as of August 11, 2024

Ordinance No. 2023-148, adopted May 22, 2023, established a Future of Workforce Commission of the City of Richmond to advise the Council and the Mayor on matters involving workforce development through partnerships that facilitate training and programs for accessing employment, career, and educational opportunities.

The Commission shall be composed of fifteen members, whom the Council and the Mayor shall appoint. Of the fifteen members, Council shall appoint ten members and the Mayor shall appoint five members.

Membership shall, **to the extent possible**, consist of representatives from the school division administered by the School Board of the City of Richmond, the School Board of the City of Richmond, City Council, administrative departments of the City, J. All members of the Commission shall be **residents of the city** of Richmond and shall be broadly representative of the community with respect to race, color, religion, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions, national origin, age, marital status, disability, sexual orientation, transgender status, or gender identity.
