THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 27-195 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2020) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

Sec. 27-195. Appointment of persons to enforce certain parking regulations.

(a) The Chief is authorized to put into effect the regulations contained in sections 27-197, 27-208, 27-209, 27-214, 27-215 and 27-216 by the appointment of persons to enforce the sections in addition to the regular police officers of the City.



(b) Except as otherwise prohibited by law or as directed by the City, uniformed personnel serving under contract with the City are authorized to issue a summons or parking ticket for a violation of any regulation set forth in Chapter 27, Article VI.



PURPOSE: To amend Richmond City Code section 27-195 to include the authority for Department of Public Works (DPW) Third-Party Operator to enforce the City's parking regulations.

REASON: DPW, in tandem with the Richmond Police Department (RPD) enforcement parking operations, are seeking to use a third-party operator solicited by a Request For Proposals (RFP). The Third Party Operator (parking management firm) will provide parking management services including issuing summonses or parking tickets for violations of Chapter 27, Article VI.

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration recommends approval.

BACKGROUND: RPD has the responsibility of enforcing parking regulations. However as with many police departments of comparable size and demographics, this responsibility has been partially outsourced to ensure that adequate attention is given to the enforcement of parking regulations, the issuance of parking citations for violations of Chapter 27, Article VI.

DPW Parking Division is the City agency responsible for administering and managing all parking-related contracts. The division consist of 12 employees that oversee on and off street parking operations, citation management, and issuance of handicap, valet and meter bagging permits.
