THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 29-172 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

**Sec. 29-172. Designation of routes generally.**

Except as otherwise provided, the operation of any motorbus system of passenger transportation under this article shall be along such routes as are or shall be designated by the operator of the motorbus system of passenger transportation and subject to this article. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no vehicle operated as part of a motorbus system of passenger transportation shall make more than one turn of the same direction around the block

**ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY**

The patron requests that legislation be drafted for Council's consideration regarding the planned installation of a GRTC bus stop at N. Davis Avenue between W. Broad Street and W. Grace Street; and 2.) the installation of the proposed bus turn-around along the 2500 block of W. Grace St; pursuant to City Code Section 2-428(c). City Code Section 2-428(c) delineates procedures to be used by City Council to alter bus routes.

**BACKGROUND**

GRTC has announced installation of a bus stop at N. Davis Avenue between W. Broad Street and W. Grace Street; and 2.) the installation of a bus turn-around along the 2500 block of W. Grace St. Many residents, property owners, and business owners in the vicinity of the

planned stop and turn-around have voiced opposition to announced plans and have expressed concerns about traffic congestion in area and parking problems if current plans are executed. Council may exercise authority over bus routes in the City pursuant to City Code Section 2-428(c).
