RE: Broad Street Landscape Lighting Concepts

Dear Urban Design Committee:

The landscape lighting concepts presented to you are part of the ARPA funded Gateway Beautification Project led by the Department of Public Works. The goal is to enhance significant gateways and corridors within the City of Richmond. Broad Street was selected as a specific focus area.

The Broad Street medians are currently mulched without vegetation and have landscape planters. The desire is to landscape the vacant medians between 4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Street and install lighting to complement the new landscape along Broad Street. The lighting will have the capability of providing multi-colored static lighting.

(4) Light columns will be installed on the (2) Broad Street medians between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street medians as well as 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> street. (1) Light column will be installed on the smaller median between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Additional strip lights running parallel to the curb will face new landscaping in conjunction with up-lighting. Please see the attached exhibits for your reference.
