PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$20,000 from the E. Rhodes and Leona B. Carpenter Foundation of the City of Richmond to help defray the cost of the 61st Annual Festival of Arts at Dogwood Dell.

REASON: The City of Richmond through its Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (DPRCF) is seeking approval to accept a grant award in the amount of \$20,000 from E.
