WHEREAS, the intersection of Parkwood Avenue and South Randolph Street is located in a populous residential area of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersection to erect all-way stop signs at said intersection; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Parkwood Avenue and South Randolph Street.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersection.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Patron requests that an ordinance be drafted that requires the installation of all-way stop signs at the intersection of Parkwood Avenue and Randolph Street in order to improve the safety of the intersection for residents and drivers.

BACKGROUND

Concerns have been expressed by area residents that the safety of the intersection needs to be improved. Residents have concerns about visibility entering the intersection, and recent accident(s) and near accidents. It is believed that all-way stop signs would improve the safety of the intersection for drivers and pedestrians.
