ADOPTED SEP 22 1986

To amend and reordain Section 12-286 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning the fee to be charged and to be paid into the City treasury by persons receiving services provided by emergency ambulances providing such services pursuant to contract entered into by such provider with the City of Richmond, to except services provided by such contractual providers of emergency services if the services rendered are as a back-up provider for the Forest View, Tuckahoe, or West End Volunteer Rescue Squads.

2. § 1. That Section 12-286 of the Code of the City of
3. Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as
4. follows:
5. Sec. 12-286. Emergency ambulance services provided
6. pursuant to contracts entered into
7. between the City of Richmond and
8. providers of such services; exceptions.
9. Each person, with the exception as hereinafter
10. provided, provided emergency ambulance service pursuant to
11. any contract heretofore or hereafter entered into by and
12. between the city and the provider of such service shall be
13. charged and shall be billed as follows:
14. Ambulance dispatched and medical care rendered - \$65.00

SUMMARY

This Ordinance would amend Section 12-286 of the Code, concerning the fee to be charged to persons receiving services provided by emergency ambulances.

This amendment would not permit commercial carriers to bill for services rendered in zones covered by Forest View, West End and Tuckahoe Rescue Squads, if services rendered are as a back-up provider.
