

RE: Proposed acceptance and appropriation of the FY21 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) additional funding

ORD. OR RES. No. _____

PURPOSE: Authorizing the City Administration to accept and appropriate the additional funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance Programs grant an additional amount of Four Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Four (\$4,254.00) dollars and increasing the originally approved amount of Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000) to Seventy-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Four (\$79,254) to already established Special Fund titled State Criminal Alien Assistance Program for the Richmond City Sheriff's Office (RCSO).

REASON: The Richmond City Sheriff's Office seeks approval for additional funds in the amount of \$4,254.00 awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance Programs for the FY 2021 SCAAP Grant Award.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that this additional funding be accepted and appropriated to the Richmond City Sheriff's Office effective Fiscal Year 2023.

BACKGROUND: The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) administers the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) in conjunction with the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-

ment (ICE), Department of Homeland Security (DHS). SCAAP provides federal payments to states and localities that incurred correctional officer salary costs for incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens with at least one felony or two misdemeanor convictions for violations of state or local law, and incarcerated for at least 4 consecutive days during the reporting period. The Sheriff's Office has participated in this program for almost 20 years.

FISCAL IMPACT / COST: The total amount of this award is \$79,254.00 of which \$75,000 was already approved and appropriated in FY23. The additional \$4,254 would need to be approved for the Richmond City Sheriff's Office to use to off-set the cost of Overtime. *There is no cash match requirement.*

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: The acceptance of this award will allow the Richmond City Sheriff's Office to offset the cost of Overtime which is not fully funded for FY23.

BUDGET AMENDMENT NECESSARY: Yes, the Special Funds Budget must be amended for this Grant.

REVENUE TO CITY: A drawdown of Grant funds will be completed one time in full to offset the cost of Overtime for FY23.
