




What did PMCE do in 2024?

- created 4,226 new code cases
- issued **4,010** NOVs
 - 1,046 defective maintenance
 - 2,580 environmental
 - 308 unsafe structures



Where do we issue Notices of Violation (NOVs)?





What did PMCE do in 2024?

- closed **7,540** cases
 - **5,013** compliant
 - 2,203 no violation observed
 - 324 non-compliant
- abated 193 properties
 - \$66,798 total cost of abatement contractor(s)




What did PMCE do in 2024?

- issued 70 demolition permits
 - initiated 1 demolition
- moved 14 derelict buildings into compliance
- added 199 vacant buildings to registry
 - 550 total vacant buildings




Where are the vacant buildings?

issued 80 NOVs

identified or cited **462** violations

committed 395 staff hours
