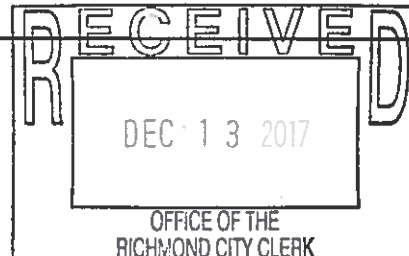

Please list your educational background and/or other expertise or qualifications you will bring to this authority, board, commission or task force: I am a graduate of Old Dominion University and after graduation completed accounting classes at VCU and University of Richmond. I am a Retired Treasury Agent/ Special Agent specifically employed by Internal Revenue Service. I was employed as a criminal investigator/expert witness for the prosecution of Tax Evasion, U.S. Bank Secrecy Act and Money Laundering Violations. I conducted financial investigations which involved complex analysis to determine correct tax liability, interviewing witnesses to obtain sworn statements and preparation of reports (with exhibits) which were used to indict and prosecute violations of the Internal Revenue Code and related offenses. I testified as the government's expert witness during every phase of the criminal case. During my employment with IRS, I also held the position of Asset Forfeiture Coordinator, managing the assets which were seized and forfeited by the IRS throughout the State of Virginia to ensure that due process was followed. My last position before retirement was Public Information Officer for IRS Virginia, handling all media contacts and press conferences for prosecutions as they were moving through the adjudication process. After my retirement from IRS, I was employed by Wells Fargo Advisors as a financial investigator in the Compliance Department, and subsequently I was the Manager of the Anti-Money Laundering team, managing the Enhanced Due Diligence Team and the Investigative Team of approximately 40 team members. My entire career I have worked in the Compliance arena, gathering facts and determining if a violation of law or procedure has been committed and what further recommended action is needed. I currently serve as Treasurer on the board of the Association of Anti Money Laundering Associates (ACAMS) for the Virginia Chapter. I hold the ACAMS certification.

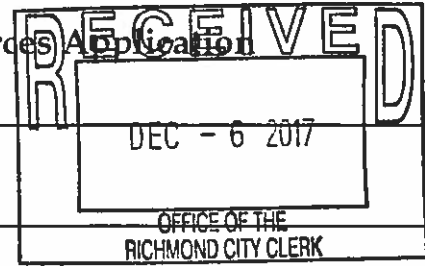

At VCU, I facilitate the individual and institutional conflict of interest in research programs. Our office works directly with the State and Local Government Conflict of Interests Act in the context of individual conflicts of interest in research; in particular, we recommend exceptions under § 2.2-3106 C.8., which otherwise prohibits state employees from having a contract with VCU other than their own employment contract. The C.8. exception is granted, upon recommendation of the Conflict of Interest in Research Committee (on which I serve), for contracts for research and development that are in the interest of VCU (i.e. support its mission). Exception recommendations involve reviewing and applying the Code of Virginia, working with multiple VCU stakeholders (including University Counsel), and working with outside stakeholders in the private sector (i.e. the small business, in which a university employee has a financial interest, that wants to subcontract work to be done at VCU). Similarly, our office works directly with procurement and other offices in order to facilitate the institutional conflict of interest in research program.

- (a) Four persons who, at the time of appointment, reside in a census tract within the city of Richmond with a poverty rate of at least 25%. At least one of the four persons shall, at the time of appointment, be a tenant of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority or a recipient of Section 8 housing vouchers from the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority;
- (b) A representative of a service provider assisting low-income individuals or families;
- (c) A representative of a community organization or advocacy group with a primary focus on the reduction of poverty and who resides within the city of Richmond;
- (d) A person who resides within the city of Richmond.

The Council shall appoint members from each of the following categories:

- (e) Four persons who, at the time of appointment, reside in a census tract within the city of Richmond with a poverty rate of at least 25%. At least one of the four persons shall, at the time of appointment, be a tenant of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority or a recipient of Section 8 housing vouchers from the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority;
- (f) A business owner or a representative of a business with a workforce made up of employees, the majority of whom reside in the city of Richmond;
- (g) A representative of a college or university located within the city of Richmond with expertise in studying poverty or in program evaluation;
- (h) A person who resides within the city of Richmond;
- (i) A member of the City Council, who shall be a non-voting member of the board and shall serve as co-chair.
