Bobb, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to enter into an agreement dated November 1, 1987, with the County of Chesterfield concerning purchase and sale of water between the City of Richmond and the County of Chesterfield modifying paragraph 2 (rate to be charged for water delivered) of agreement dated December 1, 1979 (executed pursuant to adoption of Ordinance No. 79-210-187 on November 5, 1979), as amended by agreement dated December 1, 1983 (executed pursuant to adoption of Ordinance No. 83-277-252 on December 19, 1983).

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the City Manager, Robert C. Bobb, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement dated November 1, 1987, with the County of Chesterfield concerning purchase and sale of water between the City of Richmond and the County of Chesterfield modifying paragraph 2 (rate to be charged for water delivered) of agreement dated December 1, 1979 (executed pursuant to adoption of Ordinance No. 79-210-187 on November 5, 1979), as amended and modified by agreement dated December 1, 1983 (executed pursuant to adoption of Ordinance No. 83-277-252 on December 19, 1983), such agreement to be substantially as follows:

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT made this 1st day of November, 1987, by and between the CITY OF RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, a municipal corporation of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hereinafter referred to as "City", and the COUNTY OF CHESTERFIELD, VIRGINIA, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hereinafter referred to as "County";

WHEREAS, it is deemed mutually beneficial to both the City and the County to amend the aforesaid contract;

NOW, THEREFORE,

W I T N E S S E T H:

That for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived by the City and the County, the contract dated December 1, 1979, as heretofore amended and modified by supplemental contract dated December 1, 1983, which provides for purchases or sales of water between the County and the City is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph 2. The County and the City shall pay for all water delivered by the other party at the rate of \$0.70 per Ccf.

In further consideration of the premises, the City and the County covenant and agree each with the other that the contract dated December 1, 1979, as amended and modified by supplemental contract dated December 1, 1983, between the

parties, except as amended herein, shall be and remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City has caused its name to be hereunto signed by Robert C. Bobb, its City Manager, and its seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Clerk, said action being authorized by Ordinance No. 87-249-225, adopted by the Council of the City of Richmond on the 26th day of October, 1987, and the County has caused its name to be hereunto signed its County Administrator, and its seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Deputy Clerk, the said action being authorized by a resolution adopted at a duly called meeting of the Board of Supervisors on the        day of        , 1987.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force upon adoption and effective as of December 1, 1987.

SUMMARY

This Ordinance would authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Chesterfield County concerning the purchase and sale of water between the City of Richmond and Chesterfield County, effective November 1, 1987.

**NOTE:** This agreement is primarily for emergency service. The arrangement originally began with a contractual agreement on December 1, 1979 and renewed itself every 2 years for a maximum of 4 times.

The original price 1979 - \$0.25 per 100 cubic feet  
 Amended in 1983 - \$0.40 per 100 cubic feet  
 Recommendation in 1987 - \$0.70 per 100 cubic feet

Cost per year -- approximately \$200-\$300 annually by each party. In fiscal year 1986-87, there was no use by either party.
