AN ORDINANCE No, 86-232-212

(As Amended)

To authorize the Arts Council of Richmond, Inc., to use portions of Byrd Park for holding an event to be entitled: "The Children's Festival", to allow the sale and consumption of beverages, to allow the preparation and sale of food, the sale of festival related items, and to permit presentation of live amplified music in said Byrd Park, on October 9, 10, 11 and 12, 1986.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning sale of merchandise in the public parks of the City of Richmond, and any other applicable provisions of law of the City to the contrary notwithstanding, the Arts Council of Richmond, Inc., may use portions of Byrd Park (specifically excepting tennis courts and baseball diamonds) for an event to be entitled and known as "The Children's Festival", may sell and permit consumption of beverages and food (such sale of food and beverages to be coordinated through the City's contracted concessionaire for the area of the City including Byrd Park) on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, October 9, 10, 11, and 12, 1986.

2. The Arts Council of Richmond, Inc., shall not be authorized to use the tennis courts nor baseball diamonds in Byrd Park. It may close interior roads to traffic, erect temporary stages, tents and structures and hang banners and signs. The Arts Council of Richmond, Inc., may sell festival related items, e.g., tote bags, T-shirts and related items. In addition the presentation of live, amplified music shall be permitted.

3. Since the City of Richmond is a co-sponsor of "The Children's Festival", no indemnification or insurance shall be required of the Arts Council of Richmond, Inc.

4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 9, 1986, and shall continue in force until 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 12, 1986, provided, however, the usual hours for closing of the park must be observed.
