





Ethics Reform Commission

Ordinance No. 2019-264, adopted November 12, 2019, established the Ethics Reform Commission of the City of Richmond with indefinite duration for the purpose of providing to the Council and the Mayor information and advice concerning the implementation of the recommendations from the Ethics Reform Task Force.

The Richmond City Council Ethics Reform Commission shall be composed of **eleven members** whom the Council and the Mayor shall appoint. Of the eleven members, the **Council shall nominate nine members** and the **Mayor shall nominate two members**.

Members should be **broadly representative of each of the City's nine Council districts** and have experience and expertise in ethics rules and regulations in the government or private sector, procurement, human resources, related legal issues, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), and other code of ethics areas.
