- 9. UDC recommends the Applicant to conduct public outreach, including community meetings and direct engagement with surrounding neighborhoods, to solicit and document community input.
- 10. UDC recommends the Applicant to provide updated renderings demonstrating the interaction of the final design with the public right-of-way and street-level façade.
