THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning sale of merchandise in the public parks of the City of Richmond to the contrary notwithstanding, The Daily Planet may use the Triangle Park at Floyd Avenue/Morris Street/Brunswick Street for a yard sale on Saturday, September 7, 1985. The Daily Planet shall provide liability insurance, naming the City of Richmond as an additional insured in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000 and shall comply with all other provisions of law and regulations of the City regarding use of public parks, traffic and crowd control, and tax and similar laws of the City as a requisite for obtaining permission for such usage.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 7, 1985, and shall continue in force until 1:00 p.m., Saturday, September 7, 1985.

At its meeting of August 19, 1985, the City Planning Commission voted
(8-0-1 abstention) to recommend APPROVAL of:

Ordinance No. 85-217

To permit Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority,***to encroach into, on, over, across, and upon Marshall Street from a point 33 feet,***west of an extension of the west right of way line of a north-south alley***to a point 27 feet,***west of the former west right of way line of 6th Street, with existing underground encroachments***as shown***on a plan***in the Department of Public Works designated Drawing No. N-21379, etc.

The Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority has requested approval of two existing underground encroachments into Marshall Street adjacent to the Blues Armory. The encroachments are necessary to accommodate utility services for the 6th Street Marketplace. One of the encroachments involves a bank of electrical ducts extending between the Armory on the north side of Marshall Street and the existing R.R.H.A. parking deck on the south side of the street. The other involves chill water lines extending along the north line of Marshall Street between the Armory and the site of the new parking deck under construction west of 6th Street. The utilities in question were installed prior to encroachment approval to avoid delay in the Marketplace construction schedule, and appropriate plan review and inspection processes were followed. The encroachments do not interfere with public use of the street right-of-way. The ordinance contains the normal conditions regarding maintenance, liability protection for the City and restoration of the street.
