(f) A business owner or a representative of a business with a workforce made up of employees, the majority of whom reside in the city of Richmond;

(g) A representative of a college or university located within the city of Richmond with expertise in studying poverty or in program evaluation;

(h) A person who resides within the city of Richmond;

(i) A member of the City Council, who shall be a non-voting member of the board and shall serve as co-chair.
