

Resolution to appoint Foster Curtiss as Inspector General.

BACKGROUND

Resolution is requested to appoint Foster Curtiss as Inspector General effective May 13, 2025.

This request is in accordance with Richmond City Code § 4.19: "There shall be an inspector general who shall be appointed by the council for an indefinite term and who shall be qualified by training and experience for the duties of the office. The inspector general shall have the power to appoint such assistants for the performance of the duties of the inspector general's office as the council may provide for. It shall be the duty of the inspector general to conduct such investigations as may be authorized by § 15.2-2511.2 of the Code of Virginia [Code of Virginia, § 15.2-2511.2].
