THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning sale of merchandise in the public parks of the City of Richmond, and any other applicable provisions of law of the City to the contrary notwithstanding, the Carillon Civic Association of the City of Richmond may exhibit and sell arts and craft items and other merchandise and promote and undertake activities usual and customary to the observance of the annual public festival known as "Arts in the Park" to be held upon the Carillon grounds in Byrd Park on Saturday, May 2, and Sunday, May 3, 1987. The Carillon Civic Association shall comply with any laws or regulations of the City requiring the purchase of licenses, concerning security, sanitation, and hours of operation and shall also obtain

general liability insurance in an amount of \$1,000,000 in which the City of Richmond shall be named as an insured.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at the first moment of Saturday, May 2, 1987, and shall continue in force until midnight Sunday, May 3, 1987.
