THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and hereby is amended by adding in Chapter 21, Personnel, Article I, a new section numbered 21-4, as follows:

Sec. 21-4. Advertisement of job vacancies in the unclassified service.

All vacancies for positions of employment in the unclassified service, other than temporary or acting positions, shall be advertised in at least one newspaper of general circulation, may be advertised in professional journals and other publications when appropriate, and shall be posted internally for the information of all city employees. Each advertisement and posting shall include the minimum qualifications required, the time, place, and manner for making application; and shall denote that the City of Richmond is "An Equal Opportunity Employer."

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
