PURPOSE: To amend Ordinance No. 2022-055 which adopted the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 General Fund Budget by accepting \$4,000 in anticipated revenues from the sale of surplus property and by increasing appropriation to the Department of Procurement Services expense budget. The intent of this O&R is for City Council to accept and appropriate additional revenues anticipated from the sale of surplus property for the purpose of paying expenses incurred for online and inperson sale of surplus tangible personal property.

REASON: Per council ordinance #2022-055, this appropriation is necessary to recognize revenue and contractual expenses associated with the sale of tangible personal property.

RECOMMENDATION: City Administration recommends adoption of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with City Code, Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 15, Section 2-594 (2), the Department of Procurement Services is responsible for selling, trading, or otherwise disposing of surplus goods belonging to the City.
