The Patron requests a resolution requesting that the Mayor submit a budget amendment, or amendments, to the FY19 Capital Improvement Plan (Ordinance No. 2018-059) for appropriation of the amount assigned to the Capital Maintenance Reserve from the FY18 General Fund Balance for maintenance of Roads and Sidewalks.

BACKGROUND

Summary:

- The amount proposed by the administration for assignment to the Capital Maintenance Reserve from the Estimated, Unaudited General Fund Balance as of June 30, 2018 is \$2,045,132.
 - o This amount represents the 40.0% of the Estimated Surplus that is required to be assigned to the Capital Maintenance Reserve under the provisions of Ordinance No. 2017-215.
 - o Once the Final, Audited General Fund Balance as of June 30, 2018 is available, the amount that must be assigned to the Capital Maintenance Reserve under the provisions of Ordinance No. 2017-215 may vary from the estimated amount of \$2,045,132.

Capital Maintenance is already required by Ordinance No. 2017-215. The proposed resolution expresses the desire of City Council that these funds be utilized for maintenance of roads and sidewalks.
