To amend and reordain Section 2-38 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning opinions of the City Attorney.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Section 2-38 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 2-38. Opinions.

When his opinion is requested on any question of law, the city attorney shall require the request therefor to be in writing, when practicable, and shall respond in writing as often and as fully as is practicable. A copy of each opinion shall be kept on file in his office and shall be made available for inspection of any person affected thereby or having an interest therein. ~~[The-city-attorney shall, biennially, as soon as practicable after the beginning of the calendar year, cause the opinions to be printed and bound in suitable form for distribution among the departments, bureaus, boards, commissions, offices, agencies and courts of the city and for preservation and use by others,--The number of volumes to be printed and bound~~

~~shall-be-fixed-by-the-city-council-upon-the-adoption-of-the-general-fund-budget-appropriating-funds-for-the-purpose.]~~

The city attorney shall prepare periodic indexes of such opinions and may distribute such indexes among the departments, bureaus, boards, commissions, offices, agencies and courts of the city.
