#### Ordinances & Resolutions for Consideration

## 1. Ordinance No. 2025-222

**Patron** Mayor Avula

## Key Points:

- Amends City Code § 27-302, concerning towing and storage fees, for the purpose of modifying the limits on fees charged for the towing, storage, and safekeeping of certain vehicles removed from private property.
- Increases allowable towing fees from \$135 to \$195 while allowing additional fees of no more than \$30 per vehicle towed on Saturdays and Sunday.
- Provides for acceptable methods of payment, meaning cash, certified, check, or money orders.
- Provides that the Towing Advisory Board shall meet periodically to recommend adjustment to fees as established in the Code.
- Members may wish to ask when fees were last raised.
- Members may wish to ask about the differences in fees charged for tows involving State.
