Subject: Request for Review and Amendment to City Ordinance 97-245-257.

Summary

The property located at 2809 North Avenue is governed by Special Permission Ordinance 97-245-257, and is owned by and operated as a clinic of Capital Area Health Network (CAHN).

The property located at 2811 North Avenue is a zoned for Residential Single Family Dwelling, and is a vacant lot. Also owned by Capital Area Health Network.

Since December 2016, CAHN has built a parking pad on 2811 North Avenue and have illegally used the lot for a commercial business parking lot.

Since December 2016, and at the onset of the construction of the parking pad, I have complained to the city development, zoning, and permits offices about the residential lot being used for commercial purpose/parking.

The last known review of City Ordinance 97-245-257, by City Council, was on February 13, 2006.

Since February 13, 2006,

- a much larger business, CAHN, has purchased and improved the property, but has more traffic and employees than the 1969 origination or the 2006 review of City Ordinance 97-245-257 had anticipated, with regard to traffic and parking.
- CAHN purchased the Residential lot next-door at 2811 North Avenue and has been using it for a
 parking lot, against zoning code, and enforcements warnings.
- CAHN has abused City Ordinance 97-245-257 repeatedly, daily for 2 years, and seems to think it is entitled to apply the same generous permissions for 2809 to 2811 North Avenue.

I have created a brief 17 minute video of my Amendment Request that includes supporting documentation, photos, violations, development, and property damage. Best of all my video proposes a solution that would satisfy the residents of North Barton Heights, adjacent homeowners, CAHN and their clients and employees, and the City of Richmond.
