To authorize the senior citizens who are members of senior citizen centers operated and sponsored by the City of Richmond to exhibit and sell arts and craft items made by such senior citizens and promote activities usual and customary for a senior center in [~~Forest-Hill-Park~~] Byrd Park on Thursday, May 21, 1987.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. The provisions of Article VIII of Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning sale of merchandise in the public parks of the City of Richmond, and any other applicable provisions of law of the City to the contrary notwithstanding, senior citizens who are members of senior citizen centers operated or sponsored by the City of Richmond may exhibit and sell items made by such senior citizens and promote activities usual and customary to the observance of the annual public festival known as "Senior Extravaganza", to be held on Thursday, May 21, 1987, in [~~Forest-Hill-Park~~] Byrd Park. Laws and regulations concerning obtaining licenses, hours of operation and providing security and sanitary facilities shall be observed.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect at the first moment of Thursday, May 21, 1987, and shall continue in force until midnight.
