MOTIONS TO AMEND

1. To amend Ord. No. 2017-129, which authorizes the special use of the property known as 1704 Arlington Road for the purpose of an illuminated canopy with canopy signage, to provide that only the canopy signage and not the canopy itself will be illuminated.
2. To amend Res. No. 2017-R033, which requests that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be conducted by an independent third party a review of the City's program for the collection and disposal of bulk items and brush solid waste pursuant to City Code § 23-44, to further request that such review include the collection and disposal of leaves.
3. To amend Res. No. 2017-R035, which requests that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be conducted an inventory of all parcels of City-owned real estate to identify surplus and underutilized parcels of City-owned real estate, to modify the information to be included in the inventory.
4. To amend Res. No. 2017-R069, which requests that the Mayor include in his proposed Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budgets proposed appropriations sufficient to cover the cost of the second and third phases of the plan to adjust the compensation of sworn police officers and sworn firefighters, to update the statement of anticipated amounts that will need to be appropriated.

5. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept grant funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 from Optima Health Group, Inc., and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities by \$5,000.00 for the purpose of providing interactive health lessons focusing on nutrition, chronic diseases, and physical fitness. **{No Committee Referral Pursuant to Rule VI(B)(3)(c)}**
6. To amend Ord. No. 2017-036, adopted May 15, 2017, which adopted the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 General Fund Budget and made appropriations pursuant thereto, by transferring \$325,167.00 from the Fire-Fire Operations program and appropriating \$17,464.00 to the Fire-Office Of The Fire Chief program, \$188,423.00 to the Fire-Fire Prevention program, \$61,079.00 to the Fire-Fire Training program, and \$58,201.00 to the Fire-Logistics program, for the purpose of ensuring appropriations for pay adjustments properly reflect the assignments of personnel within the Department of Fire and Emergency Services. **{No Committee Referral Pursuant to Rule VI(B)(3)(c)}**

7. To amend Ord. No. 2017-036, adopted May 15, 2017, which adopted the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 General Fund Budget and made appropriations pursuant thereto, by transferring \$2,681,334.00 from the Police-Administration program and appropriating \$18,683.00 to the Police-Chief of Police program, \$839,037.00 to the Police-Support Service program, \$62,693.00 to the Police-Office Of Professional Responsibility program, and \$1,760,921.00 to the Police-Area I and Area II program, for the purpose of ensuring appropriations for pay adjustments properly reflect the assignments of personnel within the Department of Police. **{No Committee Referral Pursuant to Rule VI(B)(3)(c)}**
8. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$15,053.00 from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Justice Services by \$15,053.00 for the purpose of funding salary increases for grant-funded employees of the City's community corrections program. **{No Committee Referral Pursuant to Rule VI(B)(3)(c)}**
9. To rezone the properties known as 904 Oliver Hill Way, 908 Oliver Hill Way and 1020 Oliver Hill Way from the M-1 Light Industrial District and the M-2 Heavy Industrial District to the B-5 Central Business District. (Mayor Stoney – By Request) **{Planning Commission – October 16, 2017}**
10. To authorize the special use of the property known as 3138 Grayland Avenue for the purpose of two single-family detached dwellings, upon certain terms and conditions. (Mayor Stoney – By Request) **{Planning Commission – October 16, 2017}**
11. To authorize the special use of the property known as 15 East Brookland Park Boulevard for the purpose of permitting a café with accessory roasting, wholesale, and distribution of coffee products, upon certain terms and conditions. (Mayor Stoney – By Request) **{Planning Commission – October 16, 2017}**
12. To designate The Maggie Walker Community Land Trust as a land bank entity for the purpose of assisting the City in addressing vacant, abandoned, and tax delinquent properties and to authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement setting the terms and conditions of such designation. (Vice President Newbille, Mr. Agelasto, and Mrs. Robertson) **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – October 17, 2017}**
13. To amend and reordain ch. 2, art. V of the City Code by adding therein a new div. 10 (§§ 2-1002—2-1008) and a new div. 11 (§§ 2-1035—2-1041) and to amend ch. 12 of the City Code by adding therein a new art. V (§§ 12-201—12-218) for the purpose of establishing an Education, Health, and Human Services Grant Commission, a Visual and Performing Arts Grant Commission, and related grant programs for nonprofit organizations to be administered by each commission. (Mrs. Larson) **{Finance and Economic Development – October 19, 2017}**

14. To amend section 27-302 of the City Code, concerning towing and storage fees, for the purpose of modifying the limits on fees charged for the towing, storage, and safekeeping of certain vehicles removed from private property. **{Finance and Economic Development – October 19, 2017}**
15. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Cooperation Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority for the purpose of facilitating the design, planning, engineering, and construction of certain infrastructure improvements to support a mixed-income rental housing development at 1501 North 31st Street and 1611 North 31st Street in the city of Richmond. **{Finance and Economic Development – October 19, 2017}**

RESOLUTIONS

16. To impose enhanced speeding penalties pursuant to City Code § 27-163 and to authorize the placement of signs giving notice thereof on the portion of Kimrod Road located between Orcutt Lane and Bryce Lane. (Mr. Jones) **{Public Safety – September 26, 2017}**
17. To request the Richmond delegation to the General Assembly of Virginia to introduce and support the enactment of legislation to amend section 5.05, concerning the duties of the Mayor, and section 5.05.1, concerning the duties of the Chief Administrative Officer, for the purpose of providing that the Mayor, the Chief Administrative Officer, and their designees no longer have a right to attend closed meetings of the City Council. 18. To name a parcel of City-owned property located at 1907 Texas Avenue as “Riverview Community Park.” **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – October 17, 2017}**

To express the sense of the City Council that the General Assembly of Virginia should grant the City Council the authority to cause the removal of memorials and monuments such as the statues commemorating J.E.B. Stuart, Robert E. Lee, Jefferson Davis, Thomas “Stonewall” Jackson, and Matthew Fontaine Maury located on Monument Avenue between its intersections with Belmont Avenue and Lombardy Street so that the City Council may take such action as may be necessary to cause these statues to be removed. 20. To establish, pursuant to City Code § 12-206, the per capita amounts to be used to determine budget appropriations for nonprofit organization grant programs beginning with the Fiscal Year 2018-2019. (Mrs. Larson) **{Finance and Economic Development – October 19, 2017}**
