

LUHT Presentation Schedule: Jan-July 2026 (+ fall/winter topic list)

Objective: Identify a schedule of agency presentations and written submissions for monthly meetings of the Council's Standing Committee on Land Use, Housing, and Transportation (LUHT), covering January-July 2026, with a list of potential additional topics for the remainder of the year. Topics were selected based on shared strategic goals, action plans, and codified report requirements.

Proposed Timeline:

- Across Dec-January, review proposed schedule with Chair, DCAOs, CAO, and Committee members to evaluate feasibility and interest/value in various topics and proposed dates.
- At January public meeting, confirm proposed schedule (as a discussion item).
- Reconvene in ~June 2026 to confirm specific plans for Fall/Winter 2026 schedule.
