WHEREAS, the intersections of West 7th Street and Perry Street, West 7th Street and Porter Street, and West 7th Street and Bainbridge Street are located in a populous residential area of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersections to erect all-way stop signs and mark cross walks on all approaches at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected and crosswalks shall be marked on all approaches at the intersections of West 7th Street and Perry Street, West 7th Street and Porter Street, and West 7th Street and Bainbridge Street.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected and crosswalks have been marked on all approaches at the aforesaid intersections.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron requests that legislation be drafted for Council's consideration that requires the installation of all-way stop signs and cross walks at the following intersections along 7th Street: 7th Street and Perry Street, 7th Street and Porter Street, and 7th Street and Bainbridge Street.

BACKGROUND

Business and residential users of this intersection have voiced concerns about speeding in this area and concerns that this endangers pedestrians and vehicular traffic. It is hoped that the installation of all-way stop signs and cross-walks will lessen the dangers to users and improve safety for the public at these intersections.
