To amend and reordain Sections 30-218, 30-219 and 30-220 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, concerning the rates to be charged for general water service in the City of Richmond, for residential water service within the City and general water service outside the corporate limits of the City of Richmond.

1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That Sections 30-218, 30-219 and 30-220 of the
3. Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, be and are amended and
4. reordained, as follows:
5. Sec. 30-218. Residential water service - City.
6. (a) Application. This section shall apply to use
7. of service for residential purposes in individual residences
8. or owner-occupied duplexes at locations within the corporate
9. limits of the city where service is available.
10. (b) Minimum charge for water. The monthly minimum
11. charge is the service charge.
12. (c) Service charges (readiness to serve). Service
13. charges shall be [~~\$5.25~~] \$5.46 per month.
14. (d) Commodity charge. Monthly charges for the
15. quantity of water which passes through the meters shall be
16. as follows:

6. (e) Term of contracts. Contracts for water service
7. under this schedule shall be cancellable at any time;
8. provided, that a consumer cannot resume service within one
9. month at the same location without paying the prescribed
10. service charges and charges for water supplied during the
11. intervening period in accordance with this schedule.

12. (f) Special provisions (cost of water adjustment).
13. The charge specified in the monthly commodity charge may be
14. subject to an adjustment per 100 cf for increases or
15. decreases in the costs associated with the cost of electric
16. energy, water treatment chemicals and purchased water.

17. Sec. 30-219. General water service - City.

18. (a) Application. This schedule shall apply to use
19. of service for other than individual residences or owner-
20. occupied duplexes at locations within the corporate limits
21. of the city where service is available.

22. (b) Minimum charge for water. The monthly minimum
23. charge is the service charge shown below, determined by
24. meter size.

1. (c) Service charges (readiness to serve). The
 2. following monthly service charges shall be paid by consumers
 3. for the use of the following sizes of meters. The service
 4. charges shall be paid in addition to charges for the
 5. quantity of water which passes through the meters. When a
 6. consumer is supplied with water through more than one meter,
 7. the service charges shall apply to each meter:

5. (h) Term of contracts: Contracts for water service
6. under this schedule shall be cancellable at any time;
7. provided, that a consumer cannot resume service within one
8. month at the same location without paying the prescribed
9. service charges and charges for water supplied during the
10. intervening period in accordance with this schedule.

11. (i) Special provisions (cost of water adjustment).
12. The charge specified in the monthly commodity charge may be
13. subject to an adjustment per 100 cf for increases or

16. Sec. 30-220. General water service - County.

17. (a) Application. This section shall apply to use
18. of service for all purposes at locations outside the
19. corporate limits of the city where service is available;
20. provided, however, that this schedule shall not apply to
21. contracts heretofore or hereafter entered into between the
22. city and any adjoining county.

23. (b) Minimum charge for water. The monthly minimum
24. charge is the service charge shown below, determined by
25. meter size.

1. (c) Service charges (readiness to serve). The
 2. following monthly service charges shall be paid by consumers
 3. for the use of the following sizes of meters. The service
 4. charges shall be paid in addition to the charges for the
 5. quantity of water which passes through the meters. When a
 6. consumer is supplied with water through more than one meter,
 7. the service charges shall apply to each meter:

7. (h) Special provisions (cost of water adjustment).
8. The charge specified in the monthly commodity charge may be
9. subject to an adjustment per 100 cf for increases or
10. decreases in the costs associated with the cost of electric
11. energy, water treatment chemicals and purchased water.

12. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effective
13. for all bills rendered for Cycle 1 in July 1986 and any and
14. all bills rendered subsequent thereto.

SUMMARY

This Ordinance would amend and reordain Sections 30-218, 30-219 and 30-220 of the Code of the City of Richmond, 1985, to establish new rates to be charged for general water service in the City of Richmond, for residential water service within the City and general water service outside the corporate limits of the City of Richmond.
