

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS: § 1. That section 9-2 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:
Sec. 9-2. Central absentee voter election district.

There is hereby established for the City a central absentee voter election district, for use in all elections. The polling place of the central absentee voter election district shall be on the ~~second floor~~ first floor of the Office of the General Registrar located at 2134 West Laburnum Avenue, Richmond, Virginia. The central absentee voter election district shall conform in all respects with Code of Virginia § 24.2-712.

BACKGROUND

The Central Absentee Voter election district (CAP) is the precinct that processes all absentee ballots on Election Day.

This O&R is to amend §9-2 which designates the location for the central absentee voter election district for the purpose of relocating the central absentee voter election district

from the second floor of the Office of the General Registrar to the first floor of the Office of the General Registrar.

The Office of the General Registrar anticipates that the notice will be included in the notice which must be mailed to all voters due to the completion of the city's redistricting efforts. This change is not expected to have any fiscal impact, therefore no budget amendment is requested at this time. It is anticipated that this notice will be mailed to all voters in August. Section 24.2-306 of the Code of Virginia prohibits changes to polling places within 60 days of a general election. As such, this ordinance must be adopted by September 8, 2022. Notice of this proposed change must be published prior to enactment once a week for two successive weeks before adoption.

The requested introduction date is June 13, 2022.


