THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 6.15:1, "Coliseum Renewal Fund", of the Charter of the City of Richmond, a sum not exceeding \$96,435 from the Coliseum Renewal Fund, same being the estimated receipts authorized in said Charter provision to be paid into the Coliseum Renewal Fund, be and is hereby appropriated from the said Coliseum Renewal Fund for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1986, and ending June 30, 1987, for the purpose of rebuilding, replacing, expanding, and renewing the Coliseum structure and fixed assets necessary for the operation of the Coliseum; provided, however, that any expenditure herein authorized shall be subject to availability of the funds herein appropriated.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect July 1, 1986.
