





No current Council members, officers, or employees of the City shall be eligible for appointment... four ex-officio, non-voting members recommended by the Mayor, one of whom shall serve as a representative of the Department of Public Utilities, the Department of Public Works, the Office of Sustainability, and the Richmond and Henrico Health District and (ii) four non-voting members consisting of one public utilities department head, or the designees thereof, each employed by the counties of Hanover, Henrico, Chesterfield, and Goochland, respectively.

Additionally, Kevin has researched Richmond's gas utility and published guest columns in the local news.


