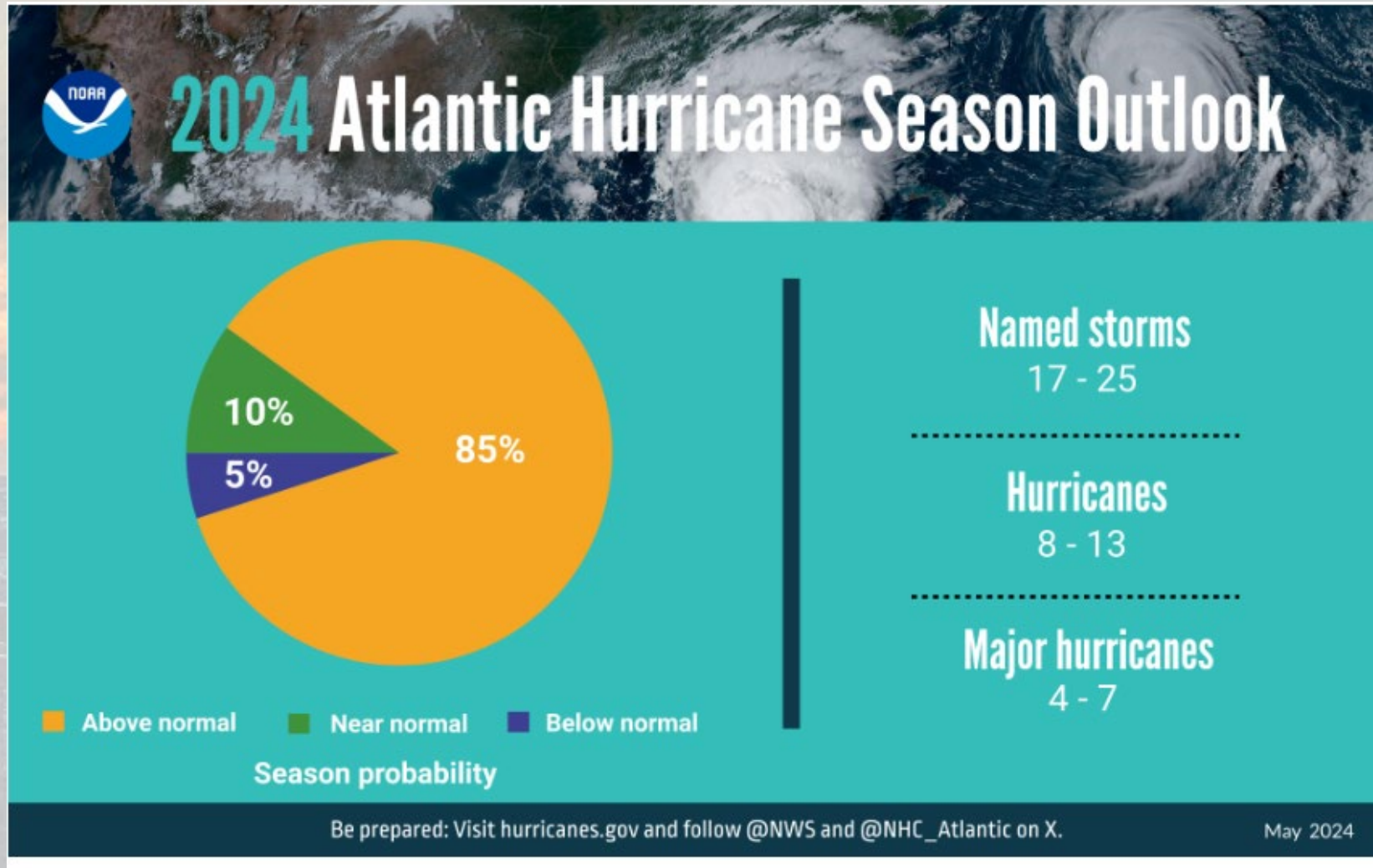

Three Named Storms

- Tropical Storm Alberto – 17 June Texas
- Hurricane Beryl – 28 June Category 4 Texas
- Tropical Storm Chris – 30 June SW Gulf of Mexico

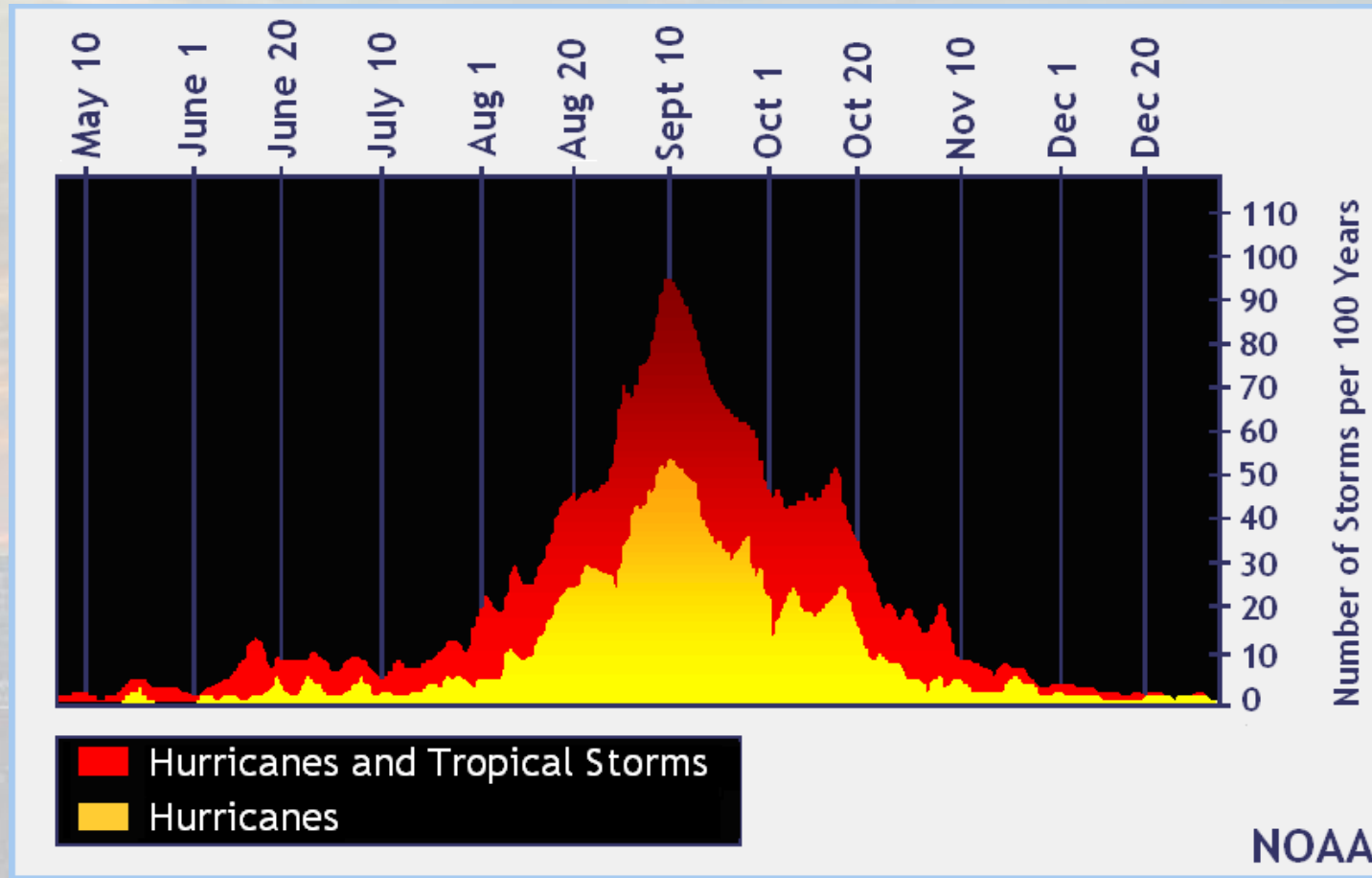


Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale

- Category 1: Winds of 74–95 mph, minimal damage to buildings, trees, and signs
- Category 2: Winds of 96–110 mph, extremely dangerous winds will cause extensive damage
- **Category 3:** Winds of 111–130 mph, devastating damage
- **Category 4:** Winds of 130–156 mph, catastrophic damage
- **Category 5:** Winds over 157 mph, catastrophic damage



Hurricane Season Peak Chart



Hurricane Season is forecast to experience La Nina conditions (the absence of higher vertical wind shear)
