

1. 28-422, or as a pawnbroker or operator of a pawnshop under
2. section 28-434, or desiring to sell or offer to sell at
3. retail, pistols or revolvers, or to buy at retail or other-
4. wise acquire a pistol or revolver under the provisions of
5. section 28-443, or proposing to acquire a license under the
6. provisions of section 28-441 to operate a massage parlor, or
7. to conduct a call-out massage parlor service, or proposing
8. to engage in the business of rubbing or massaging the body
9. of another for remuneration as a masseur, masseuse, massage
10. practitioner or other person engaged in and performing such
11. services under the provisions of section 28-416, shall first
12. apply to the director of public safety for a permit, and
13. shall produce to the director evidence of the good character
14. of the individual, the members of the firm, or the chief
15. officers of the corporation, as the case may be. It shall
16. thereupon be the duty of the director of public safety to
17. make a reasonable investigation of the character of the
18. individual, or of each member of the firm, or of each chief
19. officer of the corporation, as the case may be, and if he be
20. satisfied that the individual, the members of the firm, or
21. the principal officers of the corporation, as the case may
22. be, be of good moral character and fit to engage in the
23. proposed business, or to buy, sell or otherwise acquire a
24. pistol or revolver, he shall issue the permit. The form of

1. the application for the permit and the form of the permit
2. itself shall be prepared and furnished by the director of
3. public safety.

4. (b) Every person desiring a license under the
5. provisions of sections 28-383 - 28-389 or desiring a license
6. as the operator of a bowling alley, skating rink, motion
7. picture theatre or a theatre, under the provisions of
8. section 28-440, shall apply to the director of public safety
9. for a permit to conduct the business and furnish evidence
10. that the house, building, structure or room in which the
11. proposed business is to be conducted is a suitable place,
12. has facilities for escape in case of fire and is sufficient-
13. ly strong and safe and otherwise complies with the building
14. code of the city. It shall thereupon be the duty of the
15. director of public safety to make investigation of the facts
16. in connection with such application. If the director of
17. public safety be satisfied that the premises are strong and
18. safe and otherwise comply with the building code, he shall
19. issue the desired permit. The application form for the
20. permit shall be prepared and furnished by the director of
21. public safety, and shall be available in his office.

23. section, a fee shall be paid as determined by the groups
