<u>Representatives of Community Organizations</u> – One third of the members of the board shall be officials or designated representatives of business, industry, labor, religious, educational welfare, law enforcement or other major groups in the region, and persons added to the board as a result of the petition provision of the Bylaws.

At least one of the four persons shall, at the time of appointment, be a tenant of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority or a recipient of Section 8 housing vouchers from the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority;
- (f) A business owner or a representative of a business with a workforce made up of employees, the majority of whom reside in the city of Richmond;
- (g) A representative of a college or university located within the city of Richmond with expertise in studying poverty or in program evaluation;
- (h) A person who resides within the city of Richmond;
- (i) A member of the City Council, who shall be a non-voting member of the board and shall serve as co-chair.
