### **Green City Commission**

Vacancies as of November 7, 2021

The Commission shall consist of **nine (9) members**. The Council shall appoint seven (7) of the members, one of whom must have expertise in urban forestry. The Mayor shall appoint two (2) members, one of whom shall be a city employee in the Department of Public Works or the designee thereof.

Of the remaining members, one member shall be selected from each of the following fields:

- (1) Sustainability.
- (2) Green building practices.
- (3) Energy efficiency.
- (4) Environmental protection.

At least four of the Council appointees shall reside in the city or have their principal place of employment in the city in accordance with section 2-768 of this Code.

The remaining Council appointees and the Mayor's appointee other than the Director of Public Works or the designee thereof shall not be subject to any requirement that they maintain a residence or a principal place of employment in the city. All other aspects of the commission and its membership not addressed in this division shall be governed by Chapter 2, Article V, Division 1 of the City Code.





As the Historic Jackson Ward Civic Association's Infrastructure Committee chair, I insure that I speak with not over or for my community on a number of pressing concerns.
I recently applied for and secured a nearly \$15,000 grant to plant community street trees in Jackson Ward, prioritizing pedestrian and bus corridors in the historically redlined community. I am in the process of applying for a second grant, for \$25,000, to fund planting the remaining street trees. We hope that with these two grants, we will plant more than 150 trees this fall. This project has deepened my ties with a number of organizations including Groundwork and EnRichmond, and I think serves as a good model for other community planting efforts.
