**WHEREAS**, Council has previously determined it to be in the best interests of the City to create and to regulate a unified emergency medical services system in order to preserve, protect and promote the public health, safety and welfare, which determination is hereby reaffirmed; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of that goal, it is also in the best interests of the City to have such emergency medical services provided primarily through a local ambulance authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been empowered and authorized to create a local ambulance authority by the General Assembly of Virginia pursuant to the Richmond Ambulance Authority Act;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND:**

1. That the City of Richmond does hereby create and organize a public authority named the Richmond Ambulance Authority, pursuant to the provisions of the Richmond Ambulance Authority Act, Chapter 431 of the 1991 Acts of Assembly.

2. The names and addresses of the first members of the Authority are:

3. The Authority created herein shall be deemed to be a public instrumentality exercising public and essential governmental functions to provide for the public health, safety and welfare, and it is hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all those general and specific powers granted in the Richmond Ambulance Authority Act. In addition, the Authority shall have the power to conduct all other activities as may be reasonably related to the purpose of the Authority, subject to such restrictions as may be imposed by law.

4. The attached Articles of Incorporation shall be those of the Authority and are incorporated herein by reference and shall be deemed to be a part of this Resolution.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
THE RICHMOND AMBULANCE AUTHORITY**

The City of Richmond, Virginia, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hereby creates an authority pursuant to the Richmond Ambulance Authority Act, Chapter 431 of the 1991 Acts of Assembly, and to that end sets forth the following:

1. The name of the Authority shall be **THE RICHMOND AMBULANCE AUTHORITY**.
2. The name of the organizing municipality is the City of Richmond, Virginia.
3. The Authority is created and organized pursuant to the Richmond Ambulance Authority Act to provide emergency ambulance service originating in the City of Richmond, non-emergency ambulance service within the Commonwealth of Virginia, mutual aid to other jurisdictions upon the request of such jurisdictions, and to conduct such other activities as may be reasonably related to doing so, subject to such restrictions as may be imposed by law.
4. The Authority shall have eleven members, nine of whom shall be appointed by the City Council for a term of two years. The remaining two members shall be the Richmond City Manager and

the Richmond Director of Finance, both of whom shall serve during the time that they hold such offices.

5. The Authority shall enact bylaws for the conduct of its business.
