I am writing on behalf of the Historic Jackson Ward Association to respectfully request the postponement of any additional action on Ord 2020-103, 2020-104 and 2020-105 until post COVID19 restrictions that limit public gatherings. The purpose of this request is not intended to address the merits or specifics of the ordinances, but simply to ask that action on these items be paused until additional and requisite public meetings and community engagement can be held.

I was in a meeting on May 12 with Planning staff and other neighborhood community leaders. It is clear that there are still significant questions, issues and concerns that need to be addressed. I look forward to continuing to explore the impact, direct and indirect, that the proposed zoning changes will have on Jackson Ward and the other communities.

This request for a pause appears reasonable and could prove prudent.
