MISSION



The goal of RPD's Capital City Intelligence Center is to:

- Provide a law enforcement agency with the ability to capitalize on a comprehensive and expanding range of technologies for efficient and effective policing.
 - The technologies available allow law enforcement agencies and officers to respond to crime events more efficiently and deliberately, with improved operational intelligence and a proactive emphasis on officer, citizen, and community safety. However, the increasingly vast amount of data, information, and brightness can take time to manage.
 - Agencies may struggle with filtering out what is immediately vital versus what can be helpful later (e.g., at an investigative stage or in the court system) and delivering more critical and timely information to the appropriate constituencies (the officers or detectives on-scene, commanders in the field, law enforcement executives, private citizens, etc.).

MISSION



The mission of a Capital City Intelligence Center is to:

- Centralize a broad range of current and evolving technologies, coordinate sworn and non-sworn human resources, and direct the attention of both to high-crime areas, active crimes in progress, large-scale public events that may require law enforcement presence or response, and high profile or highly recidivistic offenders in the community.
- The conceptual definition and the actual implementation of an RTCC may be very different depending on resources; the nature of crime in a community; citizen, governmental, and other stakeholder interests; and a host of other factors. Most would, and should, consider the establishment and implementation of an RTCC an evolving process that will change as time passes, as lessons are learned, and as new resources and technologies become available.
