PURPOSE: To amend Ordinance No. 2022-244 for the purpose of authorizing the inclusion of six (6) SUV "Chase" vehicles to the existing Vehicle Lease Agreement between the City of Richmond, as lessor, and the Richmond Ambulance Authority, as lessee.

BACKGROUND: Section 2.03(g) of the Charter of the City of Richmond authorizes the City to lease personal property. Through Ordinance No. 2022-131 the City authorized funding to purchase vehicles for use by Richmond Ambulance Authority and to cover the cost of equipment to make the vehicles fit for use. Further, Ordinance No. 2022-202 was adopted to amend the fiscal year 2023 General Fund budget and to authorize the appropriation. Subsequently, Ordinance No. 2022-244 was adopted to authorize the lease of, with emphasis added, "certain ambulances owned by the City."

However, as a part of the City's subsidy to the Richmond Ambulance Authority for FY 2025, the City agreed to purchase, and then lease to the RAA, six (6) SUV "Chase" vehicles - non-transporting vehicles used to support ambulances and paramedics in the event of an emergency.

This ordinance request serves to expand the language of the prior lease agreement authorization from, "certain ambulances owned by the City," to, "certain personal property owned by the City." This will provide the City broader authority to lease vehicles and other personal property to the Richmond Ambulance Authority, including the six (6) SUV "Chase" vehicles in FY 2025.
